Due to the high attendance last year and the current guidelines from our Diocese regarding Covid-19, registration will be tiered for this upcoming school year. Those families who have both parents working outside the home and need care five days a week will be accepted first. Next will be families needing care 4 days a week, then 3 days per week, etc.

When registering for the number of days needed, please note you are committing to that schedule August through May. This is the best way for us to provide quality care within the new guidelines as well as have the appropriate number of employees scheduled. Our full-time Kindergarten through 6th grade students will get first preference during registration. If at any point throughout the school year we have availability for drop-ins or preschool students we will make the announcement via the TeacherEase email system.

We ask that you discuss as a family how our days will be a little different this year at Pups Club. We will maintain social distancing according to the diocesan guidelines and group play (board games, Legos, etc) will not be an option at this point in time. We will still incorporate group activities as often as possible and keep doing fun things like bingo, movie days, random acts of kindness etc. Activities such as crafting, art and reading time will occur more frequently. All students will be encouraged to spend some time on their homework on a daily basis. Students should always have a book to read in their backpack. Students will need to have a mask with them at all times. We will provide each student with their own labeled bag of art supplies to prevent sharing items between students. All of these details will be explained to students on our first day! Please make sure you and your child are aware of these changes prior to registration and make sure it is a good choice for your student.

Our pickup will look a little different at the beginning of school as well. If your student is scheduled for Pups Club and you/a grandparent etc decide to pick up after school...instead of calling or texting a change in plans, we ask that you let them check into Pups Club as originally scheduled and pickup after 3:15. This will prevent any confusion at 3:00 for not only your student but teachers, office staff and Pups Club employees as well. There will be an employee at the top of the steps with a phone/walkie talkie. You will let them know who you are and what students you need to pick up. Students will gather their belongings and will be released to you at the top of the stairs. This will prevent multiple parents/grandparents from entering our area of care and increasing our numbers in one area.

Although this is a year full of new changes for all of us, our promise to our Pups Club families remains the same. Our goal is to keep your child in a safe environment, provide an after school snack, spend time outside as weather and guidelines allow and incorporate our crazy fun ideas to keep your child entertained after school. We appreciate your cooperation as well as your trust and patience.

Registration paperwork drop off night will be on Wednesday July 15th from 5-7:00pm at the grade school. If you are not able to drop of paperwork you may send another family member or friend to drop it off for you. No early registration forms will be accepted. You will pull through the circle drive and a Pups Club employee will come to your vehicle for you to hand over paperwork.
