


# September

## Safe Environment Training


Safe Environment Training (formerly PGC) is required by the Springfield Diocese for all school volunteers. If you are in

## Color Days

Once a month we will be having color days. These days will coincide with the color we are focusing on for that month. This is a fun way to reinforce the different colors we will be learning about. We ask that your child wear clothing of that color and bring in a picture or a small object that is that color. If you do not own clothing in that color please do not feel like you have to go out and buy something special. If your child chooses to bring in a picture it can be cut out of a magazine, printed off the computer or colored by your child. If they bring in a toy or object please make sure it is school appropriate and fits inside their backpack. All pictures and objects will be returned the same day. If you happen to forget about the color day, please know that it is okay! We have color stamps and stickers along with plenty of items for your child to find around the classroom for color day.

Our first color day will be Red Day on Thursday, September 21st.



## Reminders

Please be sure to check your child's backpack after each class. We send their work and notes home and want you to be informed of all the classroom happenings. Please keep in mind that drop off begins at 7:50 a.m. and ends promptly at 8:05 a.m. If it is after 8:05 a.m. you will need to park and walk your child down to our classroom through the front office doors. When dropping off, you must wait for the teacher to get your child out of the vehicle. You will drop off on the North side of the school. Please enter the driveway closest to the school playground. Pull up close to the sidewalk to form a line. When it is your turn pull up to the coned area and I will come to your vehicle. Please have your child exit on the rear passenger side door as this poses the safest option and keeps them out of the line of other vehicles or busses that may be entering.

At pick up time please display your child's school pick up sign. Many like to rubber band these to their passenger visor and flip it down at pick up. Pick up will in the same location starting at 10:50 a.m. and ending at 11:05 a.m. If you arrive past 11:05 a.m. please notify the school office. You will then need to park and come into the school office to pick up your child.

Thank you for being patient as we work out the drop off and pick up routine.



## Snack Day

We have 15 students in our class. Please send in enough snack and drink for the whole class when it is your child's assigned day. We ask that drinks be 100% juice or milk in the jug/bottle, please no juice boxes. Napkins and cups will be provided by the school.
