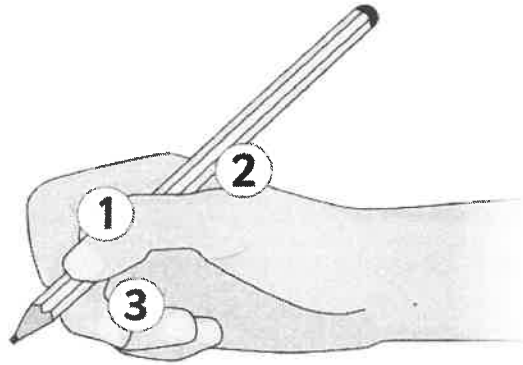
A few reminder:

If you would like to help your child work on their pencil grasp please refer to the diagram . A tip to try is to have the children hold a cotton ball in the three folded fingers. Giving them something to hold helps encourage the correct "tripod grasp"
(we call it the alligator hold at school also).

How to Hold a Pencil



1. Put your thumb and forefinger just above the cone shaped part of the pencil.
2. Let the pencil rest between your thumb and forefinger.
3. Then put your middle finger underneath for support.

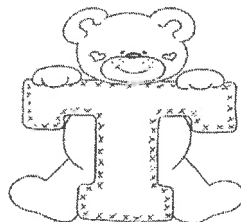
Teddy Bear Tea Party
