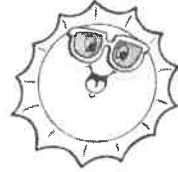

Kindergarten Students

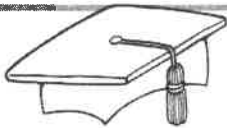
Those students moving on to Kindergarten next year need the following paperwork:

Please continue to practice upper and lower case letters and sounds over the summer months! Here are a few ways to make it fun while keeping those skills fresh!

- Write names and letters with sidewalk chalk
- Fill up water balloons write letters on them, have your child say the letter and sound before tossing
- Use a stick to write numbers, letters and name in the sand at a beach
- Hide magnet letters in Orbeez or slime for some sensory outdoor fun
- Continue to practice alphabet upper and lower case recognition over the summer!



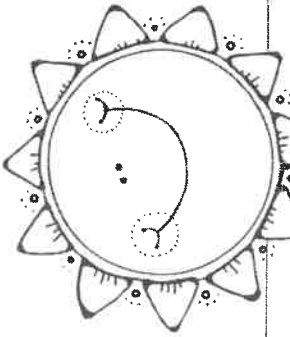

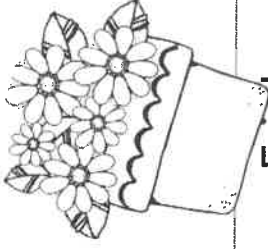
