## Drop off/Pick up

Please remember that drop off begins at 12:15 p.m.

Please be sure to wait for the teacher to pick your child up from the car. Pick up for preschool begins at 3:15 p.m.

A word of advice, do not come prior to 3:15 as grade school pick up will be in progress. If you arrive early the teachers on duty will ask that you circle around the block and reenter the pick up line closer to 3:15 to avoid a back up off cars. Also, if your preschooler has older siblings you can make one trip through parent pick up to pick all your children up at once. We just ask that the older students wait outside with the teachers on parent pick up duty until we arrive to load the students.



### Snack

We have 13 students in our class this year. On your assigned snack day please send enough snack and drink for the whole class. Homemade or prepackaged snacks are fine to send. We ask that any fruits be prepared ahead of time (i.e. grapes: washed and halved, strawberries: washed and halved/quartered, clementine/oranges: peeled and sectioned, etc. Bananas are fine to leave whole with peel on, blueberries are fine left whole). Our preference, if sending juice, would be for it to be in a bottle instead of juice boxes.
