
Also, if sending juice, a bottle is preferred over juice boxes.




Pencil Grasp

If you would like to help your child work on their pencil grasp please refer to the diagram below. One thing we do at preschool is to have the children hold a cotton ball in the three folded fingers. Giving them something to hold seems to help encourage the correct "tripod grasp".

How to Hold a Pencil



- 1. Put your thumb and forefinger just above the cone shaped part of the pencil.
- 2. Let the pencil rest between your thumb and forefinger.
- 3. Then put your middle finger underneath for support.
