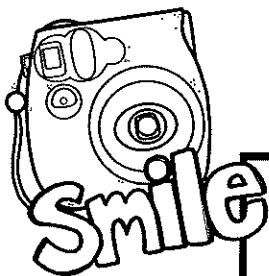

Please note that if St. Anthony Grade School has a scheduled half day of school neither session of Pups' Patch Preschool will attend that day unless otherwise communicated to parents.

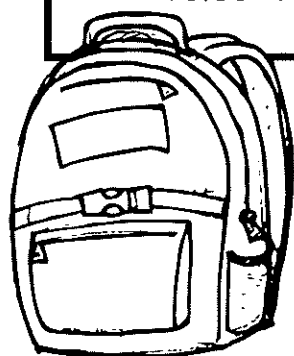
## Safe Environment Training

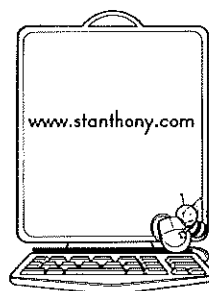
### Reminders

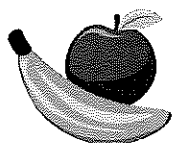

### Snack

We have 16 students in the four year old class. On your assigned snack day please send enough snack and drink for the whole class. Homemade or prepackaged snacks are fine to send. We ask that any fruits be prepared ahead of time (i.e. grapes: washed and halved, strawberries: washed and halved/quartered, clementine/oranges: peeled and sectioned, etc. Bananas are fine to leave whole with peel on, blueberries are fine left whole). Our preference, if sending juice, would be for it to be in a bottle instead of juice boxes.

- Letter Learning Day: Add one item to your bag that starts with the letter sound written on your bag.


