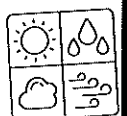

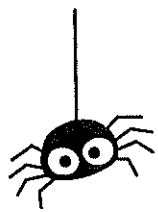

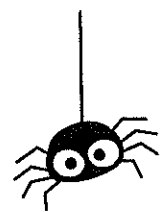

As the fall weather approaches please be sure to check the morning temperatures and dress your child accordingly. It can get cool waiting outside of the building in the mornings and at recess.





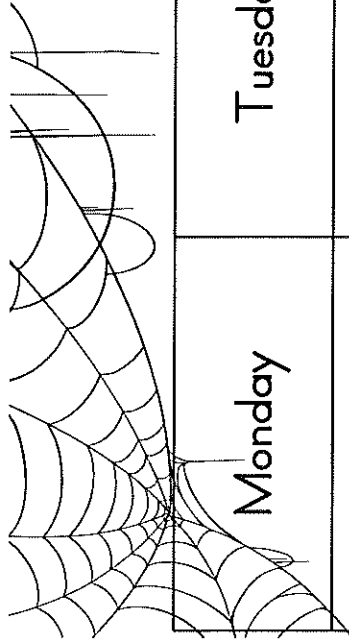

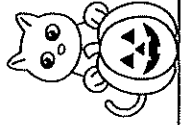
