





If you would like to help your child work on their pencil grasp please refer to the diagram . A tip to try is to have the children hold a cotton ball in the three folded fingers. Giving them something to hold helps encourage the correct "tripod grasp"

(we call it the alligator hold at school also).

How to Hold a Pencil



- 1. Put your thumb and forefinger just above the cone shaped part of the pencil.
- 2. Let the pencil rest between your thumb and forefinger.
- 3. Then put your middle finger underneath for support.

Alphabet and Name Practice

Please encourage alphabet recognition practice at home. A great way to do this is by playing games. At times I will send games home for you to play with your child that we also play here at school. Another fun one is to get an Alphabet Memory Match game and play it with your child.

Start out with 5 letters and build on from that!

When your child is writing their name at home please encourage proper pencil grasp. The first letter of their name is only in an uppercase, the rest of their name must be in lower case formation. Thank you for all your support at home!

<u>Jackets</u>

As the fall weather approaches please be sure to check the morning temperatures and dress your child accordingly.

It can get cool waiting outside of the building in the mornings and at recess.
